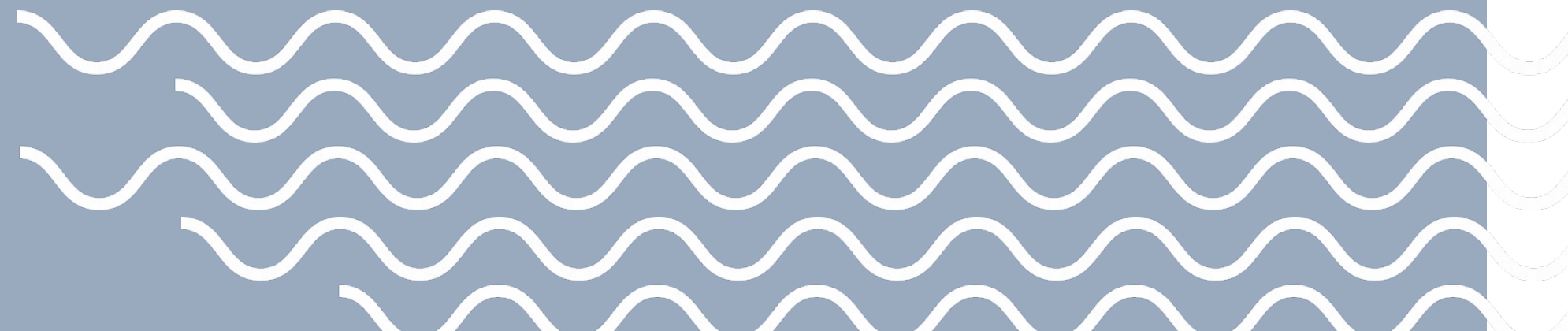

# JACOB

- 1- The birthright: Esau had the birthright as the first born son which meant he would get a double portion of everything Isaac had. Jacob would get a single portion.
- 2- The blessing: This was like a prophetic word spoken over the oldest son that had great meaning. It was a passing down of the leadership and direction for the future of the family.
