

I Will Follow You... kind of


- We REBEL (2 Peter 2:20-22)

What changed in Peter?

- Matthew 26
- Peter followed Jesus
- Peter swore an oath to Jesus
- Peter ran away when Jesus needed him
- Peter denied Jesus three times
- Peter repented... what happened?

• Pre-crucifixion

Apostles were fishing and caught nothing all night Jesus asked them to put the nets out again There was a miraculous catch of fish Peter responded Peter was told not be afraid and that he would begin "catch men"

Luke 5:1-11

When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, "Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man!"



Peter's Response

- Peter sees and experiences the glory of Jesus
- Peter looks at himself and ONLY sees a sinful and faithless man
- Peter pushes Jesus away
- Peter does not grasp his mission from Jesus

When I am NOT following...

- I DENY (John 12:9-11) Disassociate
- I MINIMIZE (Jeremiah 6:14-15) Fragment
- I BLAME and ATTACK (John 9:28-34) Isolate

• Post-crucifixion


John 21:3-14

Peter's Response

- Peter sees and experiences the glory of Jesus
- He was in "more" sin than before!
- Peter ran to Jesus and ignored everything else
 Peter is a changed man
- Peter given his mission from Jesus to not only catch souls, but to feed and take care of them
