RUTH-TRAGEDY TO TRIUMPH

Ruth 1:1-6

- When Israel had no king everyone did as they saw fit
- This was foreshadowing that kings were coming on the scene
- The book of Ruth bridges a gap between a dark time to a time where we see God's people blessed
- The short book is packed with some remarkable concepts

RUTH-TRAGEDY TO TRIUMPH

Ruth 2:2:4-6;8

- Ruth meets Boaz
- Ruth is willing to do anything to help
- Boaz is very kind to her and allows her to work in the grain field
- He even protects her, also whenever she is thirsty his men will provide water

RUTH-TRAGEDY TO TRIUMPH

Ruth 3:9-12

- Boaz is much older than Ruth and is a guardian-redeemer of their family
- Ruth's character is becoming well known as being noble
- Boaz shows his integrity by saying there is another who is more qualified as a guardian-redeemer
- He even promises to take care of her either way

RUTH-TRAGEDY TO TRIUMPH

Ruth 4:9-10;13-17

- Boaz takes Ruth as his wife
- Naomi life has turned around -better than seven sons
- God did not forsake Naomi-she was redeemed
- Ruth and Boaz were the great grand father of Israel's greatest king
