BEGINNING WITH A RECAP

Israel was divided into northern and southern kingdoms after the United Kingdom under Saul, David, and Solomon. From 930 to ~724BC, the northern kingdom(Israel) had 20 Kings who led them to ultimate captivity by the Assyrians. Prophets were sent to warn and encourage, but they did not change-that is 200yrs The southern kingdom(Judah) also had 20 kings but lasted 136 years longer before their exile to Babylon. Today, we will look at Judah's exile

Judah committed the same sins as the Northern Kingdom-idolatry and reliance on themselves and their alliances-2 Kings 17:19-20 Ne will focus on Jeremiah Jer 2:13- forsaken God and relied on themselves Gal 3:3-why rely on the worldly ways after starting with the Spirit Jer 25:4-11-prediction that the exile will last 70 years, they were saying look, the temple is here, we are safe Jer 20:1-2-they persecuted the prophets instead Acts 7:51-53-this is the summary of the people's response to the prophets



CONTINUING WITH THE WORD

One of the most misapplied scripture is Jer 29:11 _et's do a quick overview of how to read scriptures in context Ask questions -who, when and where, what or why? Jer 29:1 – who?-not you Jer 29:2 – when and where?-after the second wave of exiles Jer 29:4-23 - what? Then we see the context of Jer 29:11-12 God does not forget his people and promises restoration Jer 29:13-God calls for repentance, and he is ready to forgive
